



# DRESSING ROOM VOLUNTEERS

We require multiple volunteers to assist with this task.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Supervising / monitoring the dressing room for unwanted behaviour, and report concerns to the Director of Volunteers.
- The volunteer **MUST** be in the “vestibule area” of the dressing room; in order to ensure there is no unwelcome behaviour that is happening in the dressing room.
- Sessions will begin 1-hour prior to the scheduled ice time. \*
- In order to focus on assigned task(s), Dressing Room volunteers *may* not be assigned to the age division that their child(ren) play in. This will be at the discretion of the Director and/or Assistant Director of Volunteers.
- Volunteers are to ensure they have signed in for their shift. This will be verified by the Director and/or Assistant Director of Volunteers.
- **Volunteer Bond Category – Sign-up Required. “1 Shift = 1 Credit.”**

**\*Note:** Session starts may vary depending on the final schedule.

## **Supervision Policy**

The Dressing Room Supervision Policy is applicable to all age categories within SW Hockey, and is as per the Hockey Calgary Rules & Regulations, as follows:

- As per Hockey Calgary Rule 27: “*These adults will endeavor to prevent disorderly conduct, bullying and vandalism in any form.* These adults may be any team official or adult selected by the Head Coach or Team Manager. Failure to comply with this supervision may result in the suspension of the Head Coach for a period of at least one game. Any adult found complicit with the undesirable activity will be suspended for a period of at least one (1) year. This applies within all four streams of Hockey Calgary sanctioned hockey; with the exception of U21.”

**IMPORTANT:** For all additional Southwest Hockey Programs/Events; the Supervision Policy remains in effect as a proactive measure to ensuring the safety of the players, and will be scheduled accordingly.

- Consequences to not complying with the Supervision Policy will be dealt with on a case-by-case basis; with direction from the SW Hockey Board Executive and/or from Hockey Calgary as required.
