Email Communications

It has been brought to the Associations attention that those who have shaw.ca email addresses, are not receiving registration confirmations.

This is a Shaw server that is rejecting TeamSnap addresses. Therefore, any members who have Shaw emails are encouraged to 'safe-list' the following email addresses.

Check Junk/Spam Emails

It's a good idea to check your junk and spam folders on a regular basis.

Not only is this key so you don't miss general information, **but is critical to ensure communications are not missed once evaluations begin.** This is a perfect time to confirm emails from @southwesthockey.ca are on your 'safelist' - to minimize the chances of missing out.

Courtesy Reminder

Microsoft has been working towards moving all 'Hotmail', 'Live', 'MSN', and 'Passport' email extensions over to an 'Outlook' extension.

Unfortunately, the domino effect to this changeover is that members may not always receive their email communications because members who have one of these Microsoft "**legacy email accounts**", may have their emails randomly blocked /rejected whereby they don't receive the email even in their *junk/spam* folder.

U15 & U18

Body Checking & NON-Body Checking

U15 & U18 participants can choose, through registration, if they wish to register in a Body Checking or NON-Body Checking Division for evaluations.

NOTE

The Body Checking Division has three (3) teams; which are tiered.

There are limited spots, and typically SW has more participants choose to evaluate in this division, than there are spots available.

In these cases; participants who don't successfully evaluate within a Body-Checking Tier, will continue in evaluations, but will be moved to the NON-Body-Checking division.

Teams in the NON-Body-Checking Division are also tiered.
